Towards a Sustainable Future for Santa Cruz, Bolivia: A Multi-Disciplinary Approach



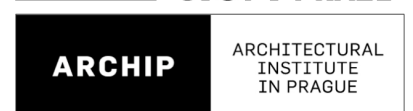

Santa Cruz de la Sierra, Bolivia, is one of the fastest growing cities on Earth. This lecture will explore the dilemmas and possibilities for a more sustainable future for the city, and ask how the environmental and social sciences might be woven with design and planning to affect positive change.

In particular it will address two principal concerns: the general lack of global awareness of development on the region's key environmental assets; and the Bolivia academy's lack of research culture that weakens different land development and management scenarios.

Dr Carl Smith is an Associate Professor of Landscape Architecture at the Fay Jones School of Architecture and Design, University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, Arkansas USA. He is first author of the book *Sustainable Residential Landscapes* (Wiley-Blackwell, 2007), and is currently editing a book on international perspectives on sustainable residential landscapes.
